

NESA coloured paper range

In order to address students' vision or perception disabilities, the NSW Educational Standards Authority (NESA) can print examination papers on a range of standard alternative colours **if**

- there is a diagnosis of a relevant disability that would require coloured paper **and**
- the student's reading test results (on white paper) are within NESA's eligibility criteria

Schools may request coloured examination papers for students through the Disability Provisions online application process.

Affected students might take this page to their health professional or diagnostician to determine the most suitable colour. NESA will not approve colours other than the range below.
